Principal's Report

Mr. Navia and Mrs. Itson presented a slide deck about return to in person learning. The slide deck will be emailed out to all families. The staff will be returning April 12th, seniors will return April 19th, and 9th - 11th will return April 26th. Families should complete the online survey to let the school know their choice. Hybrid will be alternating Mondays for all, with the A group coming on Tuesday and Wednesday and the B group coming on Thursday and Friday every week. More information on the slide deck that will be emailed. There will be no off campus lunch passes. A covid test will be done prior to students returning. If it is raining, the school will establish locations for the students. There will be no penalty for doing school online if sick. AP testing schedule will be distributed as soon as possible, but looking at the first week of June. Students were wondering if parking passes could become available in order to keep students off of public transportation. Mr. Navia said he could ask, but that he had asked in the past and had been told no. The school does not have enough parking in the parking lot for staff so this could be difficult.
